Droopy, drippy, drooly pumpkins,

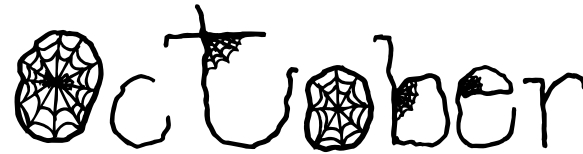
Rotten pumpkins, too.
