Cause and Effect Flip Charts

1. Students should fold their page in half long-ways.

- 2. Then open up the page and cut the "cause" and "effect" half up to the crease only.
 - 3. Then they have two "doors"... one with the cause and one with the effect.
- 4. They need to fill in a logical cause or effect, depending on which is on their paper.
- 5. Then they will lift the "cause" door and draw a picture of the cause on the space underneath.
- 6. Last, they will life the "effect" door and draw a picture of the effect on the space underneath.
