Players: 4 players

Materials: gameboard, Wonderful, Wild Weather Cards, Number Cube, Playing Pieces

Directions: Shuffle cards and lay them in a stack on the playing surface. Each of the 4 players rolls the number cube. The player with the highest roll is the "Judge." This player will check all answers during game one and will play the winner of game one in the second game. Player with the second highest roll goes first.

• To Play: Roll the number cube and draw a game card. If the player can correctly answer the weather question, he/she can move his/her playing piece the number of spaces shown on the number cube. If he/she cannot answer the question correctly, he/she cannot move and it is the next player's turn. If you answer a BONUS question correctly, take a bonus roll and move that number of spaces.

The "judge" will check all players' answers using the Answer Key to determine if correct answers are given. The first player to reach the FINISH square on the board is the winner!
